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## **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

Under close supervision, performs manual labor in the collection of solid waste. Follows instructions; procedures are well defined; may make suggestions for work improvement.

### **TYPICAL DUTIES**:

- o Loads refuse, recycling, and yard waste into sanitation or recycling trucks efficiently.
- Assists with unloading refuse or recyclables at designated sites, including landfill or recycling facilities; unloads recyclables from vehicles.
- Removes litter, debris, and refuse from streets, alleys, and public spaces, ensuring clean and safe environments.
- Collects bulk waste, including furniture, appliances, and other large items as part of special collection services; ensures proper handling and disposal of hazardous waste and large debris.
- o Performs heavy manual labor in the collection of solid waste.
- Maintains landfill sites.
- Services trucks and equipment as required; repairs refuse carts.
- o Prepares minimal records of own activities.
- Performs overtime as required, and performs other duties as assigned.

# MINIMUM EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

Any combination of education and experience equivalent to the following:

- High school diploma or G.E.D.
- Experience in manual labor, preferably in waste management, recycling, construction, or other heavy physical labor roles; knowledge of waste disposal or recycling procedures is beneficial.
- Ability to perform strenuous physical tasks for extended periods, including lifting heavy objects, running designated routes, and enduring outdoor work in adverse weather conditions.
- Must possess a valid Kansas driver's license.

### PHYSICAL DEMANDS OF ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

**Work Type:** Heavy, exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 50 pounds frequently, and/or up to 10 pounds of force constantly to move objects.

Climbing/Balancing: Climb inclines, uneven surfaces, balance required.

Walking/Running: Very extensive walking, frequent running at moderate pace required.

Stooping/Bending: Continuous.

Stand/Sit: Sit about 5 percent of the time.

## PHYSICAL DEMANDS OF ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS (CONT'D):

**Reaching:** Frequent, overhead as well as horizontal. **Vision:** Adequate to perform essential job functions.

**Color Vision:** Adequate to perform essential job functions.

**Hearing:** Seldom perceive nature of sounds by ear.

**Speech:** Seldom express ideas by means of spoken words.

**Eye/Hand/Foot Coordination:** Minimal, able to walk, push carts and work levers. **Manual Dexterity:** Minimal, able to use shovels, rakes, brooms, clutch and levers.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL DEMANDS OF ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:**

Inside/Outside: Work outside.

**Cold/Heat:** Adverse conditions possible. **Wet/Dry: Adverse** conditions possible.

**Noise/Vibrations:** Heavy packer and truck noise. **Hazards:** Exposure to traffic safety and dump areas.

Fumes/Dust/Odors: Exposure to yard dust, garbage odors and minimum exposure to fumes.

Infectious Diseases: Moderate exposure.

### MENTAL REQUIREMENTS OF ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

Ability to listen and apply information and instructions.

## MACHINES, TOOLS, EQUIPMENT AND WORK AIDS USED:

Brooms, hydraulic lifts, power washers, sanitation trucks (refuse trucks, recycling trucks, etc.), shovels, rakes and other equipment used in waste collection and maintenance tasks.
